

# Tod Andreen

Tod Andreen, 48, died Wednesday, May 18, 2011, at the Billings Clinic in Billings, Mont.

Born March 26, 1963, in Thermopolis, he was the son of Everett and Janice (Todd) Andreen. In his early 20s he spent time traveling and exploring the West.

For most of his life, Tod was a restaurant cook and was employed many years at the Sideboard Café in Thermopolis. Most recently, he was working at the Montana Rescue Mission in Billings.

Tod enjoyed being an uncle and a dad. His interests included fishing, drawing, eagles, cats, crosses, movies, plants, listening to music and reading.
