## January 27, 1943 - February 11, 2012

Larry Keith Annan, 69, died Saturday, Feb. 11, 2012, at the Wyoming Medical Center in Casper due to medical complications.

Born Jan. 27, 1943, in Riverton, he was the son of Keith Leonell and Lois (Davis) Annan. He started driving truck at the age of 16 hauling logs and graduated from Dubois High School in 1961. He later drove truck in the oil fields until retiring at the age of 54 due to ill health.

On June 1, 1963, he married Judy Thorton in Big Piney. Four children were born to this union. The family lived in various places throughout Wyoming, including Cody, Shoshoni, Big Piney, LaBarge and Riverton. The couple moved to Thermopolis in 1998.

One of his most favorite things to do would be to turn his hearing aids off and sit and watch all the grandkids play in the living room. He also liked to do woodwork and read. When he was younger, he enjoyed playing the trumpet, banjo and harmonica.
