Janet Butler Glover, 75, died Saturday, Dec. 10, 2011, at Hot Springs County Memorial Hospital in Thermopolis.

Born May 14, 1936, in Sugar Creek Township in Venango, Pa., she was the daughter of George and Goldie Pearl (Shufstall) Butler. Following high school, she graduated from Lamar College in Beaumont, Texas, and later received her master's degree from the University of Little Rock (Arkansas). A teacher, Janet taught in Houston, Texas, then grade school at Los Alamos, N.M., in 1960. Moving to Germany in 1962, she was a reading specialist teaching for the federal government in Darmstadt, Germany. In 1966, Janet returned to the states, teaching in San Diego, Calif.

On May 8, 1971, she married William H. Glover in San Diego. From 1974 to 1996, Janet taught in Pulaski County, Arkansas. The couple moved from North Little Rock, Ark., to Thermopolis in 1997. Janet held various jobs in Hot Springs County.

Janet was a member of the Methodist Church. She loved to travel, seeing most of Europe and some countries more than once. Quilting, reading and genealogy filled much of her time as well as her love for her grandchildren.

Survivors include her husband, Bill, of 40 years, of Thermopolis; stepson, Gregory Glover of O'Fallon, Mo.; stepdaughter, Michelle Stevens of Bella Vista, Ark.; sister, Nina Lee Hancock of Richmond, Va.; and several grandchildren.

Janet was preceded in death by her parents; and sister, Barbara Yeomans.

Cremation has taken place and a private family celebration of her life will be held this summer.
