

Thomas W. Hamrick

January 29, 1953 - May 29, 2011

Thomas W. Hamrick, 58, died Sunday, May 29, 2011, at Wyoming Medical Center in Casper. He was born Jan. 29, 1953, in Hillsdale, Mich., the son of Hiram L. Hamrick and Betty J. (Schuette) Hamrick.

He moved to Denver, Colo., in the early 1980s, where he met and married his wife, Pamela. While there, Thomas felt called to the ministry. He was licensed as a Minister of the Gospel and completed his Bachelor of Arts degree in Theology through Colorado Baptist University.

The Hamricks moved to Riverton in 1986, where Thomas traveled the state as a computer hardware engineer, music minister and lay preacher. In 1992, he was ordained.

Riverton remained their home until 1998, when the Hamricks moved to the Big Horn Basin in order for Thomas to pastor a small start-up church in Basin. In October 2000, they moved to Thermopolis when the members of Roundtop Baptist Church asked him to come as their pastor.

Thomas is survived by his wife; son, Michael; four grandchildren; three sisters; and three brothers.

A memorial service was held on Saturday, June 4 at Roundtop Baptist Church in Thermopolis.
