

# Harold Eugene Harvey

August 16, 1943 - June 25, 2011



Harold Eugene Harvey, 67, died Saturday, June 25, 2011, in Casper at the Central Wyoming Hospice.

Harold was born August 16, 1943 to Albert C. "Babe" and Florence (Hollandsworth) Harvey in the family home in Lucerne. He attended school in Lucerne and Thermopolis High School.
