Alice Marie Johnson, 93, died Monday, June 13, 2011, at Hot Springs County Memorial Hospital in Thermopolis.

Born June 4, 1918, in Girard, Kan., she was one of 10 children of William and Luzetta (Speights) Hutchens. Alice attended school in Dodge City, Kan.
