



Wilbur 'Bill' Lebo

September 24, 1926 - December 13, 2011

Wilbur (Bill) Lebo, 85, died Dec. 13, 2011, at the VA hospital in Denver, Colo.

Bill was born Sept. 24, 1926, in Medora, N.D., to S.N. and Lillian Lebo, one of five children. At the age of 5, his father moved the family to Thermopolis, where Bill attended Anchor School and Hot Springs County High School.

Bill was drafted into the Army during World War II and served in Italy, Japan and Korea for 12 years. He was medically discharged as a staff sergeant, due to his injuries.

He is survived by his long-time loyal companion, Laurie Studeville, of Denver; sons, David and Steven of Denver; and sister, Charline Novakovich of Casper.

Bill was preceded in death by his parents; brother, Milton; sisters, Prisella Brown and Maxine Claycomb.

Cremation has taken place and private services will be held at a later date.
