Gay S. McGee, 96, died Sunday, Jan. 29, 2012, at the Thermopolis Rehabilitation and Care Center, where she had been a resident the past two years.

Born Dec. 27, 1915, in Portis, Kan., to Ed and Jesse (Mills) St. Clair, she was one of eight children. The family moved to Grass Creek, where Gay attended school. She graduated from Hot Springs County High School.

On Sept. 25, 1932, Gay married John Henry McGee in Billings, Mont. She was employed at First National Bank as a bank teller for 17 years.

Gay would rather play bridge/cards than eat, according to her family. She held a Life Master in bridge. She was a member of Eastern Star. Her interests included cooking, fishing and cards.
