



# Charles Forrest McNett

**Dec. 20, 1946 - May 7, 2011**

Charles Forrest (Chuck) McNett, 64, of Thermopolis died Saturday, May 7, 2011, at Presbyterian/St. Luke's Medical Center in Denver, Colo., from complications of back injury.

He was born Dec. 20, 1946, in Chadron, Neb., to Forrest (Frosty) and Margrette McNett.

Chuck served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War from 1966 to 1968. He loved his country he so proudly served.
