Raymond Alfred Moore, 80, died Jan. 18, 2012, with his bride of 55 years at his side.

Ray was born April 22, 1931, to Tom and Minnie Moore in Powell. He was raised on Lower Sage Creek and graduated from Cody High School in 1949. In 1951, Ray joined the Navy and served in the Korean War until 1953.

On July 15, 1956, he married Judie Carol Remer. They worked in ranching and as outfitter's guides with fondest memories hunting the Ishawooa and Thorofare mountains. They have resided in Thermopolis since 1986.

Ray will be remembered as an outdoorsman for his love of hunting and fishing. Rodeo was his sport of choice and he competed in team roping, saddle broncs and calf roping. He proudly holds the first buckle issued for Wyoming high school rodeos as 1949 champion all-around cowboy. He shared his passion of rodeo in the early 70s, spearheading annual team roping for the Lions Club in Julesburg, Colo.

He is survived by wife; daughters, Penny (Bill) Lookingbill and Carol (George) Wingate; sons, Ray (Belinda) and Tom (Candy); eight grandchildren; and eight great-grandchildren.

Ray was preceded in death by his parents; two infant sons; and a brother, Tom. Memorial services are pending.
