The Hot Springs Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, November 7, 2017, at 9:00 a.m. in the Public Meeting Room at the Government Annex. Present were Commissioners John Lumley, Tom Ryan and Phillip Scheel. Also present were County Clerk Nina Webber, County Attorney Jerry Williams and Administrative Assistant to the Commissioners Penny Herdt. Chairman Lumley led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Agenda

The agenda was approved with the addition of item 3, Other Business - Title 25 Pool Discussion and an Executive Session at the end of the meeting. The agenda was later amended to add item 2.a., Regular Business - Award Senior Center Roof bid.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes of the October 3 and October 17, 2017 regular meetings were approved as pre-

FBO Monthly Report

The FBO reported 160 total recorded operations during October. There was 908 gallons of AvGas and 212 gallons of Jet Fuel sold during the month. The AWOS transmitter failed again and has been replaced with a completely new radio. GDA will be notified regarding the AWOS situation. Concrete work will be completed this week for two more T-hangars.

Maintenance Monthly Report

Maintenance Supervisor Anthony Fruciano presented his report. A bid for the Senior Center roof project was accepted from REDD Roofing in the amount of \$140,074.00. The Chairman was authorized to sign the contract with REDD Roofing pending review and approval by the County Attorney.

Road & Bridge Monthly Report

R&B Supervisor reported blading is complete for the year. LTAP will perform speed studies for the purpose of establishing speed limits on Skelton Road, Lane 7, and Lane 12. A local surveyor has been hired to establish the correct BLM easements on East Cottonwood and Hamilton Dome roads. After doing some research, it appears the WYDOT CRIP program would be a possible source of funding for the Black Mountain Road project. A meeting will be scheduled with the engineer to determine the next steps for this project.

<u>Emergency Management Monthly Report</u>

The Emergency Management Performance Grant for the time period of October 1, 2016-March 31, 2018 in the amount of \$22,225.00 was accepted by the Commissioners.

Planner Monthly Report

Planner reported the NRPC will meet November 8th. The LUPB meets November 15th. The LUPB continues work on the Land Use Plan revision with current focus on the chapter dealing with Land Use Policies. Final reports for Phases 1 and 2 of the Brownfields Study at the old airport site have been received. The results were as expected and a list has been developed regarding remediation projects which will depend on selected future uses for the site. Field work on the WPLI was completed this summer and meetings have resumed this fall. Due to the lack of support from Red Lane residents, the Red Lane Groundwater study has been halted. Grant funds will be deferred to another groundwater study if possible or the money will be returned to the State.

Youth Alternatives Monthly Report

Youth Alternatives Director reported four male and seven female program participants this month. There are two people under community service facilitation and three families being assisted with home visits/support. The Alive at 25 Class held last month had nine out-of-county participants and one local participant.

Vision Source Signature Eye Care 20/20 Savings Program

The Commissioners approved the offering of the Vision Source Signature Eye Care 20/20 Savings Program to all County employees.

<u>Homeland Security Grant - Sheriff</u>

The Commissioners accepted the State Homeland Security Program Grant for the Sheriff's Department in the amount of \$20,330.00 for the period of September 1, 2017 through March 31, 2020

Hot Springs County Joint Powers Board - Big Horn Regional Water JPB

The Commissioners agreed to draft a letter to South Thermopolis Water & Sewer District agreeing in principle to participate in the formation of a joint powers board to work with the Big Horn Regional Water Joint Powers Board to provide a source of good, safe water at a reasonable price to various entities in Hot Springs County.

Other Business

Pinnacle Bank/Public Funds Depository - The Commissioners approved Pinnacle Bank's application and accompanying resolution to act as a depository for County funds.

<u>Part-Time Assistant Public Defender</u> – The Commissioners reviewed the appointment of Lindsey Krause as a part-time Assistant Public Defender for the Fifth Judicial District. No action was required.

<u>Title 25 Pool Discussion</u> – After discussion with the Sheriff's Office personnel, it was decided not to establish a pool of agents to supervise Title 25 patients admitted to the hospital. The Sheriff agreed to notify the hospital that his personnel will respond to provide supervision as needed for all Title 25 patients brought in to the hospital, regardless of which agency initially brought the patient to the hospital.
